The 1965-66 LIONS had a very busy and successful year! Because of a lack of height, the LIONS weren't expected to be too successful this year. In pre-district play the LIONS attained a 21-2 record. The LIONS brought home three tournament trophies. They won first place in the Texarkana Tournament, second place in the DeKalb Tournament, and third place in the Iron Belt Tournament at Daingerfield.

The boys and Coach Fox are to be congratulated for their overcoming the lack of height to have the best record in the basketball history of New Boston High School.

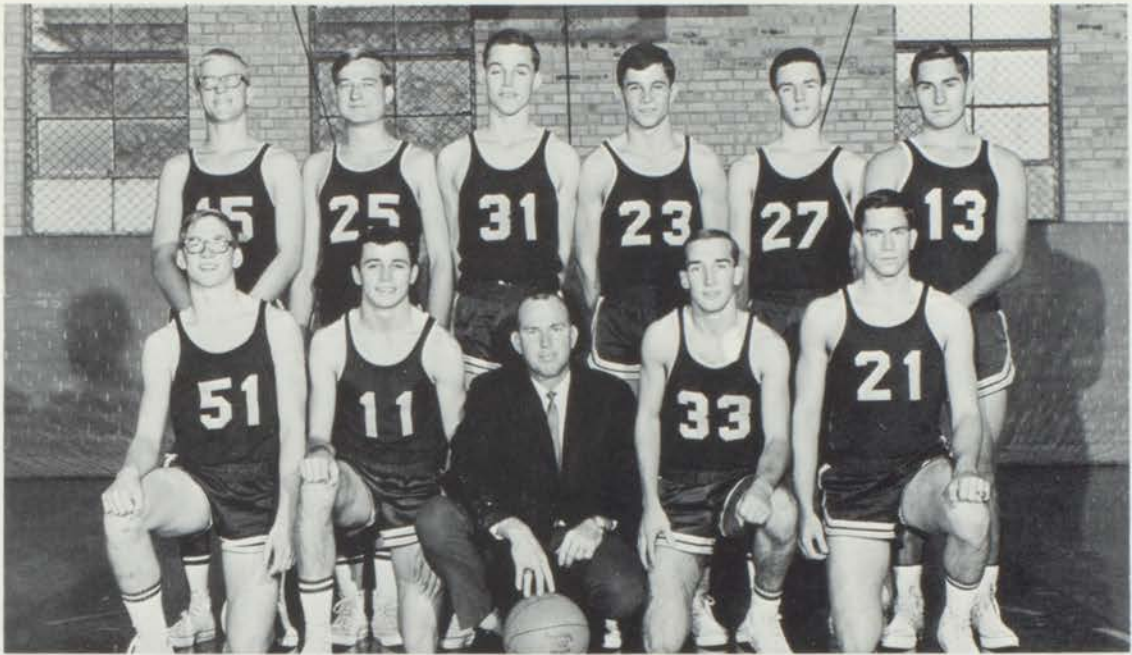
