

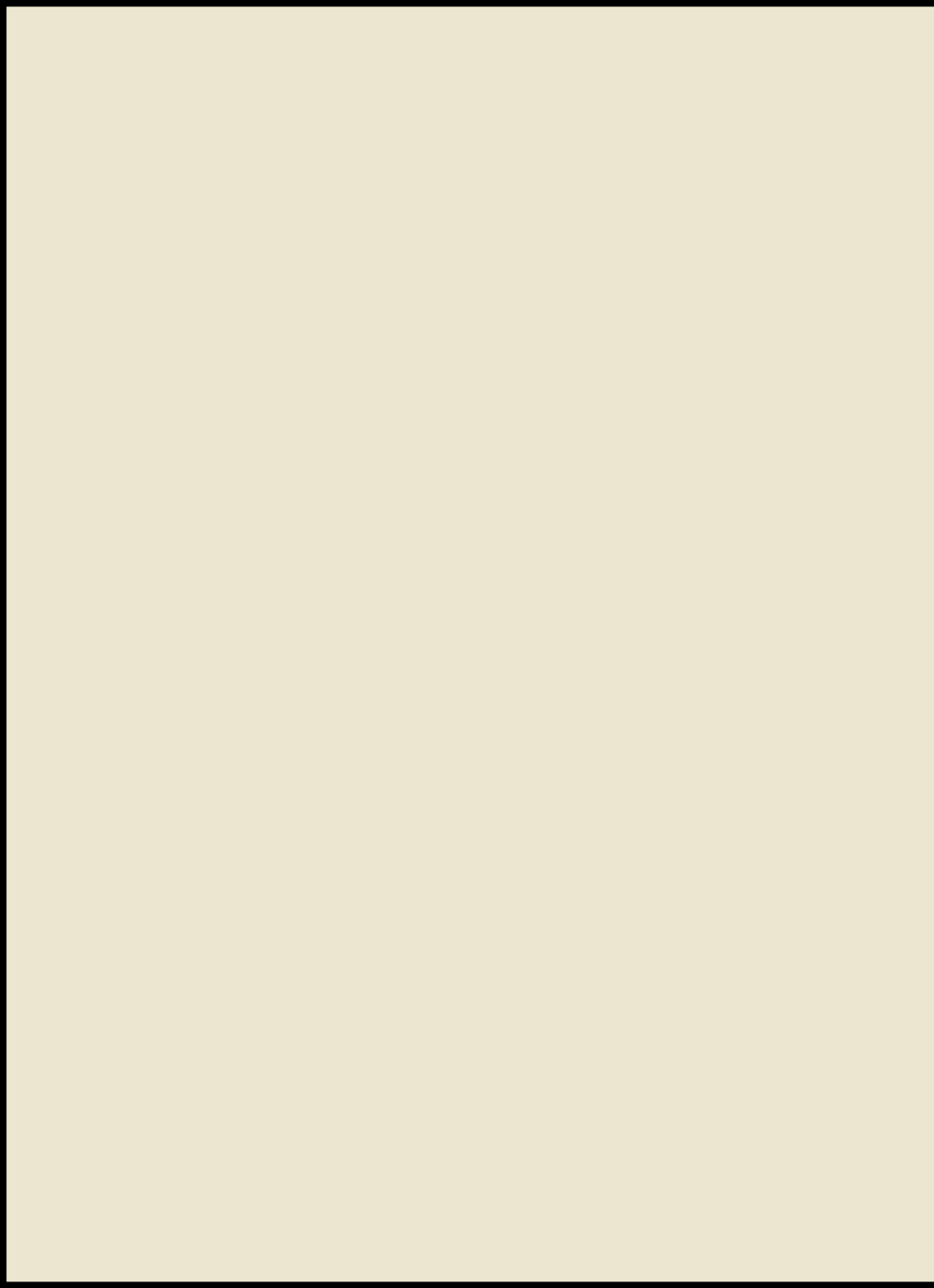

The 1967 PINE CONE moves with New Boston High-- making more Progress by the Zeal and Labor of our students and administration.

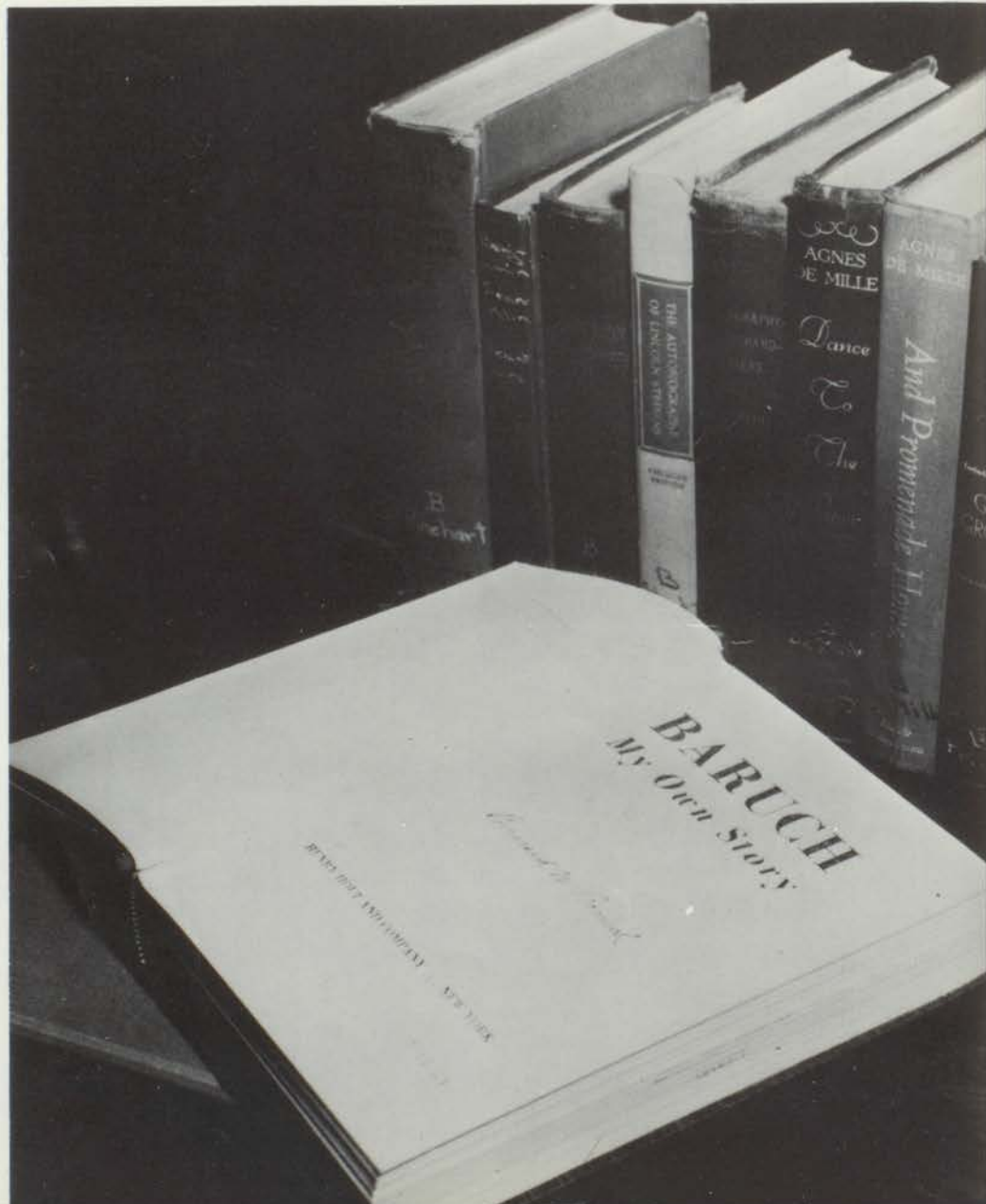
