CVAE stands for Co-ordinated Vocational-Academic Education. We have two units of CVAE: One for girls and one for boys. The students spend two hours each day in a shop or work laboratory. The boys are taught skills in the general construction trades of: carpentry, electricity, plumbing, painting, cement finishing and masonry. The girls receive training in the homemaking related field of Home and Community Services.

The students receive academic training in Math, English, social studies and the sciences on a level suited to meet their individual needs. High school students may earn four credits (two per year) in the lab section.
