The first Disaster Drill in New Boston occurred during the 1977 school year.

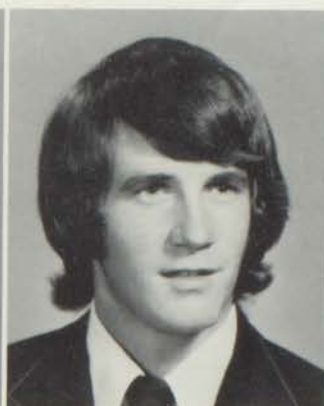
