The Rendezvous will include three full days of activities at the Fair Grounds in Texarkana, beginning Thursday.

The pony express riders, 11 members of the Texarkana Trail Riders, carried official invitations to the Rendezvous to Nash Mayor Mottie Williams, Hooks Mayor Clyde Aldridge and Doyal Eaves, standing in for New Boston Mayor Wimpie McCoy.

Henry Earl Fagan, president of the Four States Fair Association, was in Nash to meet rider Jack Brown of Naples, who delivered the invitation to Williams, and in New Boston with Eaves to greet the final rider, Tomie Twitty.

"On behalf of the City of New Boston, it's a pleasure to have these people visit our city," Eaves commented.

Each rider carried the message for approximately a mile before being relieved.

The Rendezvous is slated to open Thursday at 2 p.m., with a live flower hat contest. A balloon blowing contest

The Bowie County Commissioners Court has approved plans for the formation of a Sheriff's Reserve force here.

At a meeting Monday morning, the Court passed, by a unanimous vote, the creation of the Sheriff's Reserve, which will be made up of volunteers, at no cost to the County.

According to Sheriff Thomas Hodges, the reserves will be used whenever crowd control is called for, such as

## If jail is included

# Cost of new Court House could double

The cost of the new Court House could double, if Bowie County is forced to include jail facilities in the building project, according to County Judge Ed Miller.

Miller told members of the Court House Building Committee Monday morning that it would cost \$1-million for a jail security system alone, and that total construction would cost to \$4, to \$6, million. Current plans call for the \$6 million Court House to be built with four building cells.

Bowie County's current jail, located next to the old Court House, is expected to be replaced by a regional facility in Texarkana. The proposed jail serves Bowie County, Miller County, Arkansas, and both sections of Texarkana, and would be financed and maintained by all four government entities.

Miller said Bowie County would be hard pressed to finance the operation of its own jail facility, since federal regulations demand the presence of a jailer and a matron on duty 24 hours a day. If the regional jail is completed, all four governments would share the cost of the required personnel.

Prisoners could be kept in holding cells in the proposed new Court House in New Boston for up to 72 hours, before being transferred to Texarkana.

Current plans, drawn up by the Texarkana architectural firm of Moore, Thomas and Emberton, call for the construction of the \$6 million Court House on a 7.02 acre tract of land overlooking Interstate 35 just in intersection with Highway 8. The facility will replace the 108-year-old Court House located in Boston.

"If we go back to the drawing board if we have to build a jail," Miller commented.

Members of the Court House Committee, including Miller, Doyal Eaves, Bill Frazier, and Norman Russell, met Monday with Joe Thomas of the architectural firm, to discuss possible changes in the current plans for the facility. Thomas said due to extremely soft soil in the area, the foundation would have to be sunk approximately 20 feet below the natural grade. He suggested the construction of an underground basement, which could be used for parking at first, and eventually for additional Court House space.

The current plans, which are subject to change, call for the Court House to have two District courtrooms, on the second floor, and a County Courtroom on the first floor. The facility would also provide space for all County offices, and agencies currently housed in the old Court House.

According to Thomas, the new building will be equipped to handle the needs of the handicapped, with ramps to enter the Court House and elevators and escalators inside.

## City adopts housing ordinance

The New Boston City Council voted Tuesday night to adopt a tougher housing ordinance aimed at giving the city greater regulatory powers over the owners and occupants of buildings that may not be safe to live in.

The ordinance, passed by a vote one to two at Tuesday night's regular Council meeting, is based on the 1978 edition of the Southern Building Code. Under the law, owning or maintaining a dangerous building could be a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of up to \$200 a day.

The ordinance requires the city to provide an alleged violator with ten days' notice of a hearing before the Council. Following a hearing, if Councilmembers deem the building to be unsafe, they have the option of turning off the utilities and demanding repairs within a reasonable time period. The city would have the option to remove the building in question, if repairs were not made.

Councilman Gerald Green announced at Tuesday's meeting that he is a staunch supporter of the city's volunteer Fire Department, despite an effort by some firemen to defund them in the recent city election.

"This written campaign was primarily organized and promoted by some members of our Fire Department," Green said. "Who the Fire Department personnel, or anyone else supports in an election is none of my concern. However, I am very concerned about the faulty testimony made that I have said or would not support the Fire Department."

Green, who served as chairman of the Fire Department from April, 1979 to April, 1980, said he was directly involved in a number of Department activities during that time. He said he conducted surveys, appraisals, and site watches in order to tell city leaders that had been declared surplus. Funds obtained from the sale were designated to purchase a building for the Fire Department.

Green said the city took in \$27,772 from the sale of surplus land. He said that he approved the purchase of new fire fighting suits, at a cost of \$2,843, and helped increase pay for firemen by approximately 100 per cent for attending fire drills, house fires and grass fires.

Green said under his leadership, the city purchased
