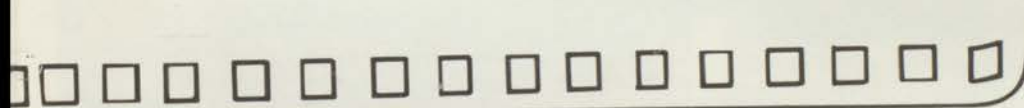
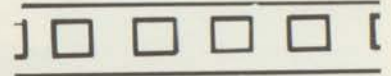
## Foreword

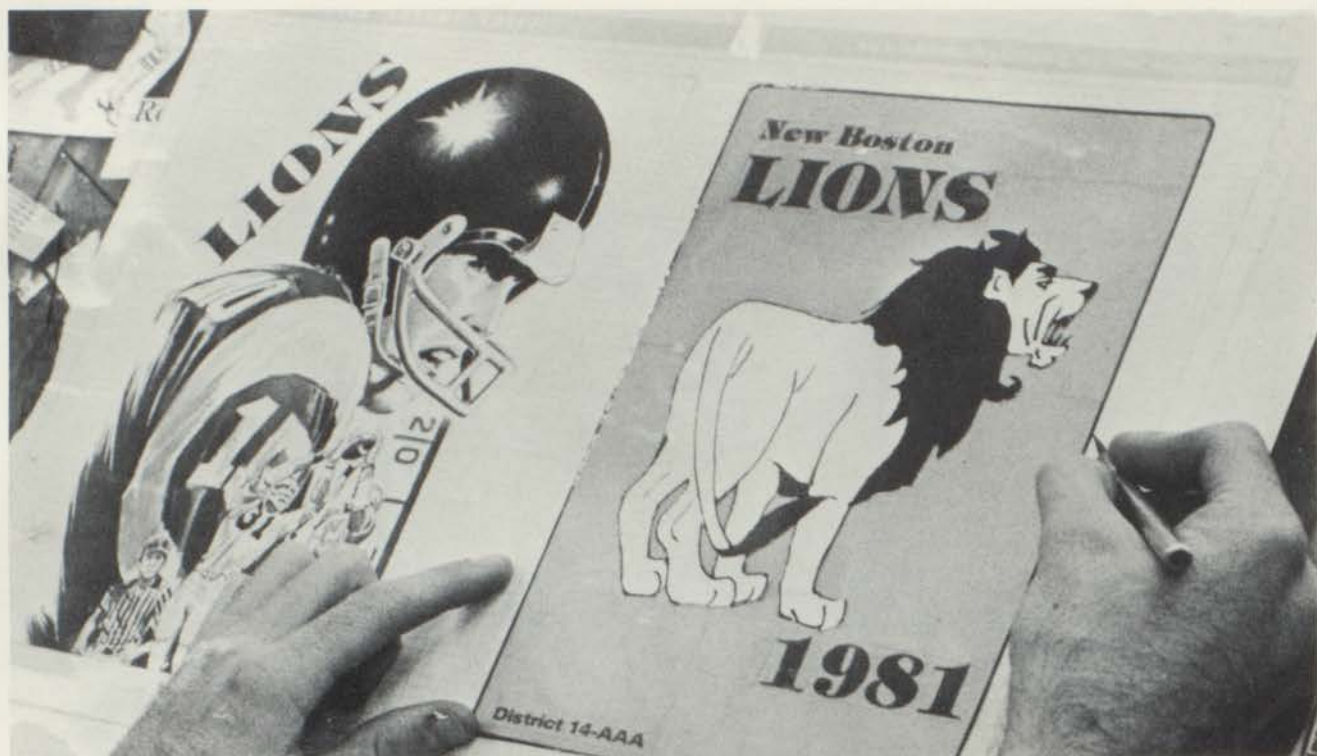

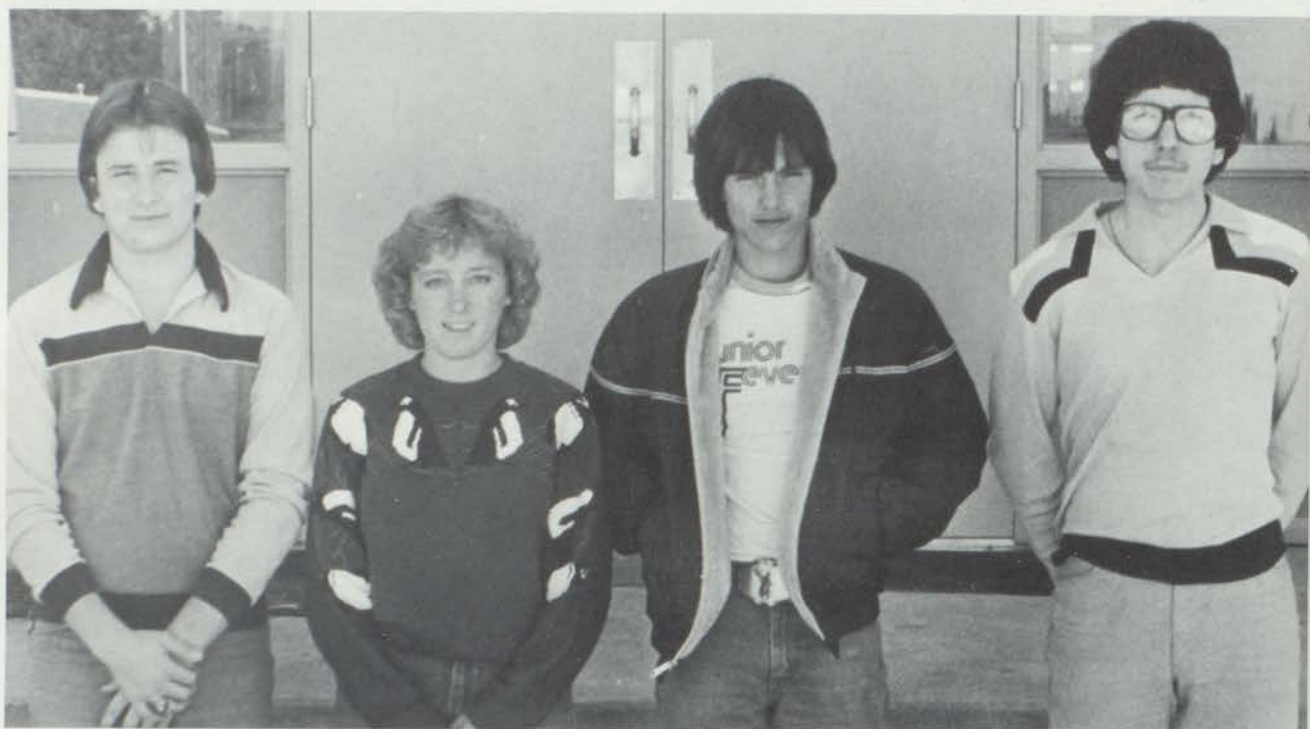


### Spanish Club

## School Board votes to keep ECR reading program

The controversy surrounding the ECR reading program may have come to an end Monday night when the New Boston Independent School District Board of Trustees voted unanimously to continue using the teaching method at Crestview Elementary School.

The Board reached the decision after a hour-long session in which reports filed by two outside consultants, Mary Anne Curington of Big Sandy, and Dr. Gerald E. Simon of East Texas State University at Texas Tech.

The study of the program came as the result of a petition presented to the School Board at its April 19 meeting, asking for the program to be discontinued. The document included 517 signatures.

According to Simon's report, the reading program is accomplishing its goals.

"On the basis of the evaluation of the teacher and student interaction, I found that the teachers were using both direct and indirect teaching skills," the report noted. "There was awareness and acceptance of student ideas, acknowledgment of student feelings, praise and encouragement. I particularly looked for students who demonstrated anxiety or ones who were uncertain of what was expected of them."

Simon's report apparently contradicts one of the arguments presented by opponents of ECR in recent months, that the program puts too much pressure on children.

"I looked for children who were discouraged by the learning tasks," the report noted. "My comparisons of these children were made with similar children observed in some 20 or more other elementary schools throughout Central and East Texas. I found the New Boston school children using ECR to be on task participating in a positive manner, enthusiastically warm and friendly, and eager to share what they were doing. Classes were well organized and the sounds of ongoing instructional processes were evident in each of the classes visited."

"The low placement for the most part was due to the hard work of your teachers," her report said. "Ms. Curington noted that teachers in the ECR program are utilizing effective management and monitoring; especially looking for students who demonstrated anxiety or ones who were uncertain of what was expected of them. permissiveness, word recognition, comprehension and study skills.

According to Ms. Curington, 80 per cent of the students' word recognition skills are taught through word structure under the ECR program. She noted that 15 per cent are taught by phonics, and five per cent by sight.

Ms. Curington's report noted that the ECR program has offered a number of advantages, including direct teaching; elimination of wasted time; standardization of teacher training; sequencing of skills to prevent gaps; organization for efficiency; administrative involvement; skillful use of reinforcement; elimination of pupils' practicing; elimination of rote learning; control of classroom variables; simplified record keeping; and teacher accountability.

According to Superintendent of Schools Hubert Simpson, Ms. Curington made some suggestions she said would improve the program, including lowering the vowel level in some classes, and making sure all teachers stick to the prescribed time schedule.

Simpson said students are supposed to spend an hour and a half a day on skills, a half hour on spelling, one hour practicing and 20 minutes

giving mastery tests.

"We're going to follow his recommendation the best we can," Simpson commented. Following the decision to keep the ECR program, Betty Archley, the leader of the group opposing the program, thanked Board members for accepting her petition and considering a change.

"I've withdrawn my right to the vote and to voice my opinion," she commented.

In other action Monday night, the Board voted unanimously to accept the annual evaluation of the school system's five-year priorities plan, presented by Jayce Houston.

According to the report, the school system is ahead of its projected goals in reading of reducing the percentage of mainstream students who perform at two or more grade levels below their actual grade placement to 16 per cent. Tests show that the figure is down to two per cent in grade three, four per cent in grade four, 10 per cent in grade five, 12 per cent in grade six, and 14 per cent in grade seven.

According to the report, 28 per cent of all students in grades four through six were reading two grade levels or more below their actual grade placement four years ago.

The report also showed that the school system ahead of its goals in its Project results for 1981-82 school year per cent are two number of deficits in grades three through eight performing at two more grade levels, the actual grade placement.
