## Hooks mayor sworn in

A new mayor and three new councilmen were sworn into office in Hooks Monday night.

The swearing in ceremony came after the old mayor, Clyde B. Aldridge, said Council certified the results of the April 7 election. Earnest

swore Aldridge by a 449-198 count, while incumbent Councilman Jackie Reed lost to Lumbley, 410-201.

Davis earned his seat on the Council by defeating Kathy Meadows, 408-133, while Harris claimed Charles Browning's seat by beating Carol Duke,

A total of 621 people voted in the election.

The Council called action on a request by part-time city employee David Malone to be re-elected to a full-time position.

### On sewerage project

## City wants to 'get something going'

The New Boston City Council and Mayor John H. McCoy have directed Public Works Superintendent Bob Walker to contact the city's engineering firm and "get something going" on a weather-delayed sewerage project.

The Council's monthly meeting Tuesday night McCoy told Walker to get in touch with the Tyler firm of Barber Branson Taylor in an effort to speed up work on the sewerage portion of the city's municipal improvements plan. The entire program, including water and street work, is being financed by \$935,000 in bonds sold last summer.

Much of the work is completed, with the major exception being the running of city sewer service to the Twin Oaks subdivision on the south side of town. Residents of the addition agreed to pay for the installation of collection lines, if the city would run the line from the treatment plant to Twin Oaks.

Work within the subdivision, which cost each of 17 lot owners approximately \$1,700, was finished last November. At a Council meeting last month, city officials told Twin Oaks residents the city would be required by the city's inability to obtain easements to run the line across private property until late December, and the wet weather.

Walker said if there is no large amount of rain this week, he expected crews to start laying the line by Monday morning.

Also at Tuesday's meeting, the Council approved a non-budgeted expenditure of \$1,250 to \$1,500 for repairs on a bulldozer.

Councilmembers accepted Walker's recommendation and approved spending up to \$600 to replace three broken pieces of playground equipment at Tapp Park.

The Council agreed to donate \$100 toward the purchase of 3' by 25' banners to be bought by the Chamber of Commerce for Pioneer Days. In the past, businesses rented streamers, but the new banners, which will cost approximately \$1,500, are expected to last for five years.

The Chamber is asking businesses to contribute to the purchase of the banners. In the past, the city has rented streamers for approximately \$100 a year.

The Pioneer Days celebration is set for June 28-30.

Councilmembers also certified the results of the April 7 election. McCoy, Walters and Councilman Paul Atkinson were all re-elected without opposition.

## NBJH to get band program

Trustees of the New Boston Independent School District approved the creation of a junior high school band program at their regular meeting Monday night.

The new program is expected to cost \$5,000 to \$6,000 next year, according to Superintendent of Schools Hubert Simpson. He said the District would save approximately \$4,000 a year in busing costs, since seventh and eighth graders will not have to be transported from the junior high to the high school for band practice.

Simpson said the new program would cost the District a total of about \$27,000, "over a period of years."

Currently, band is taught in the sixth grade at Crestview Elementary School, and in the seventh grade at the junior high. Eighth graders participate in the high school band.

According to New Boston Band Director James Coffman, the junior high band will have approximately 70 participants next year, while the high school band will have 60 to 65 members. There are currently

83 students in the high school band.

"The program will be larger, but the band you see on Friday night will be smaller," Coffman explained, noting that he expects the high school band to return to its current size during the next few years.

Coffman said the establishment of a separate junior high band is a "common practice."

"We're really the exception to the rule," he told School Board members Monday night.

The junior high band will practice in two portable buildings currently located at NBHS.

In a written report prepared for the School Board and Simpson, Coffman cited the advantages of establishing a junior high band. They include:

- "Seventh grade students would be exposed to a full band atmosphere one year sooner."
- "Eighth grade students will have a greater opportunity to be leaders."
- "Eighth graders will have a greater opportunity to play first parts more often, rather than as substitutes."

### Beavers build trouble for roads, farms

## Martin fights a losing battle

Bennie Martin spends his days and nights trying to eradicate a problem he says will never be solved.

Martin, who is employed by the Fish and Wildlife Service and lives in County, is hard-pressed with the responsibility of controlling the county's predators. He uses traps and

other methods to hunt the coyotes, bobcats and fox.

And then there's the ever-present beaver, nature's most skilled engineer.

"Beavers cause more damage than anything else," Martin said Monday, as he prepared to leave for another trapping expedition. "There's no way to exterminate what they do."

The problem with beavers, as far as farmers and county commissioners are concerned is that their well-built dams cause water to back up into wheat and soybean fields and over county roads. The damage to dirt and gravel roads is considerable, according to Phineas Three-Commissioner Dale Barrett.

Martin said he catches 60 to 65 beavers a week, using steel traps. He also speigles and shoots them at night.

He said he usually burns the dead, not concerning himself with taking their fur because "I don't have time to feed with it."

Martin said he travels throughout Bowie County in his effort to regulate the beaver population, usually covering 150 to 200 miles a day.

"Beavers are all over the county, in every little stream you find," he said.

Beaver trapping and killing beavers, Martin spends just of his day controlling their dam.

Martin has been trapping for 16 years, and has been working for the county for the past eight.

But no matter how long he works with the job, he doesn't think he'll ever rid the county of its beaver problem.

"No way," he commented as he prepared for another day of pursuing nature's most prolific builder.

### Says independent audit

## County records in good shape

Bowie County's financial records are in "very good shape," according to County Judge Ed Miller, despite an apparently inflated 1982-83 budget and the resignation of long-time Treasurer Gerald Freeman last fall.

Miller and members of the Commissioners Court accepted the 1982-83 independent audit at their regular meeting Monday morning. The document for the fiscal year ending Sept. 30, 1983, was prepared by Skaggs and Fennell, certified public accountants, of Texarkana.

Miller pointed out that \$1,453 expenditures, of \$1,237,657 were distributed because \$998,677 was in debt service principal and interest payments, a large percentage for the consideration of the courthouse. Bond payments in \$182 went into \$186,278.

Miller said the \$2.87 budget, semi-bond payment was only "2 to 3 percent" larger than the immediate predecessor.

Miller pointed out that the county will continue to receive less and less in federal funds; to \$2.83, the county budget got \$774,043 from the state and federal government, down from \$1,448,254 in 1980.

Prior to 1980, county-administered CETA job training funds were not included in the county budget.

Miller pointed out that Freeman, who resigned effective November 1 of last year after nearly 13 years on the job, was not asked or forced to give up the position. He said a spot

check of the records made after Freeman's resignation was normal procedure.

"The books are in order. I'm real pleased with the audit," Miller commented.

All Bowie County residents are invited to take part in the annual hunt. Anderson said if rains, activities will be held Monday at 9 a.m.





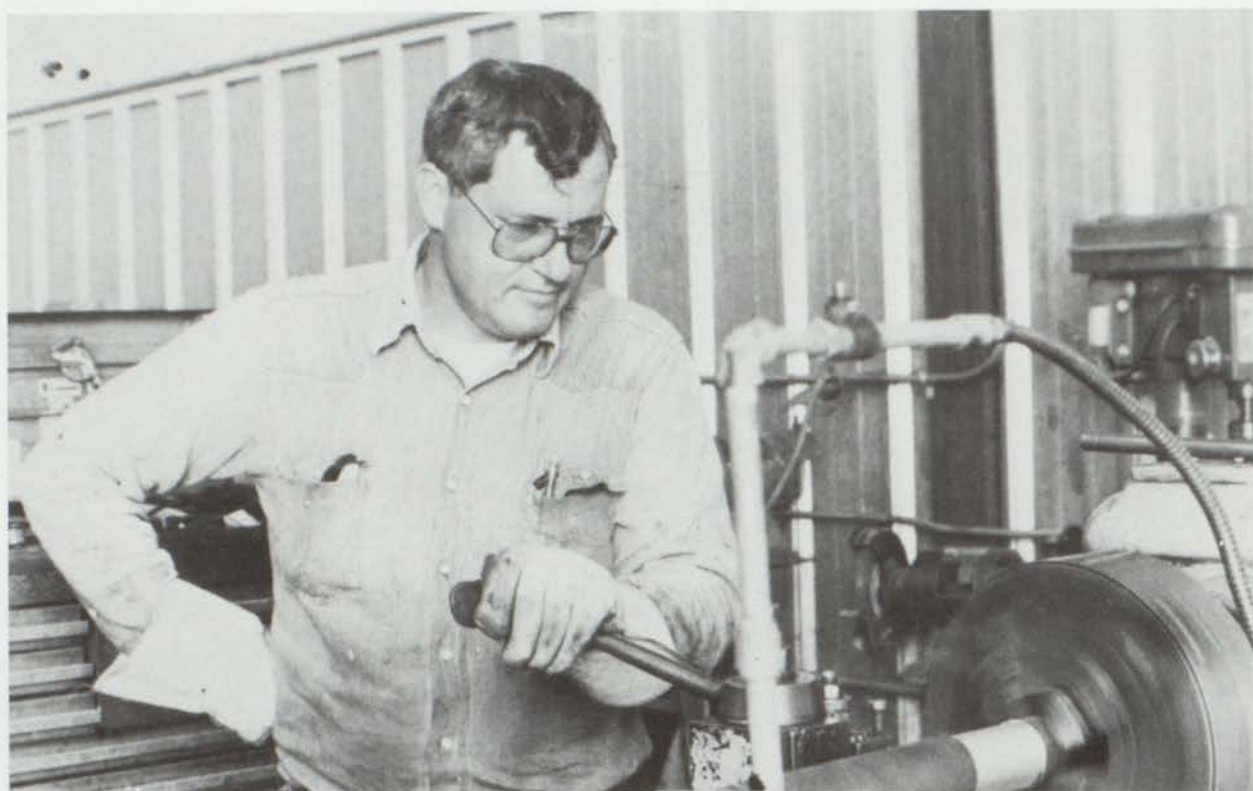
